# Ele's Place West Michigan - Tammy Squire, Director

Over the past year and moving into 2021, Ele's Place West Michigan experienced a great deal of excitement and change. It is an honor to share our 2021 achievements with YOU – our supportive donors, dedicated partners and committed volunteers, staff and community board members. We are incredibly grateful for the compassion and generosity of so many in our community in these times of uncertainty.

# TOGETHER, we accomplished the following during 2020:

- Implemented two inspiring VIRTUAL events -- Courage, Comfort & Cocktails AND the Healing Hearts Society Breakfast! We highlighted two EPWM Ambassador families' grief stories at the events. We shared how our services really did make an impactful difference in their lives.
- Redesigned and implemented our support group program in a virtual platform after the pandemic shut down inperson grief support services. We were able to recreate the safe, comforting, and open environment of our Ele's Place support groups in the comfort of our families own homes.
- Staff remained available to West Michigan families for clinical consultations, resources, and at home grief activities throughout the pandemic. We saw a 25% increase in clinical consultations with families and community agencies in 2020 compared to 2019.
- We were able to bring our school groups to several school districts in a virtual format to support the grief needs of schools and their students. We implemented a monthly resource email to our school partners to provide grief related resources and activities.
- Ele's Place staff is currently working diligently to return to in-person services this summer.

The need for peer grief support will never go away. In 2019, Michigan ranked 14th in terms of highest RISK for childhood bereavement in the U.S., and 1 in 13 children in Michigan will experience the death of a parent or sibling by the age of 18. The lifelong impact we can have on a young person who is grieving is truly limitless. Ele's Place West Michigan provides our children and teens with a confidential safe place to share their feelings and memories with peers. We help provide them with the coping skills they need to navigate their grief journey, and discover the strength and courage they possess to be the hero of their own story.

## Ele's Place West Michigan

#### Total Served in 2020:



#### SUPPORT GROUPS - 238 (171 CHILDREN AND 67 ADULTS)

Family based programming, onsite at our facilities (conducted via Zoom due to the COVID-19 pandemic.) Provides peer support to kids 3-18 and an optional support group for their caregiver.



#### SCHOOL GROUPS - 69 STUDENTS IN 9 GROUPS

Peer support groups within the school setting, primarily in Middle School and HS. Conducted in partnership with school staff.



#### **CLINICAL SUPPORT - 604 PEOPLE**

Phone, virtual or in-person one-to-one grief support, conducted by a licensed Ele's Place staff person. Includes the initial intake for families to coordinate attending onsite programs.

All services are provided free of charge to families, schools and all members of our community.




