VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

SUPPORT GROUP FACILITATOR

The primary services provided by Ele's Place is our peer support group program for children and their families who are grieving the death of a family member or close friend. These groups are organized according to the child's school and/or developmental level and serve children ages 3 - 18. The men and women who facilitate each group work in teams of three to four volunteer facilitators per group of 10-12 children or teens.

Requirements for becoming a support group facilitator:

- At least 19 years of age
- Must commit to volunteering one evening (four hours) per week for a minimum of one year
- Must complete our 23-hour facilitator training, and attend an annual In-Service session

SUPPORT GROUP PROGRAM HELPER

These volunteers assist Ele's Place staff and the support group facilitators by greeting families as they arrive at Ele's Place, assisting with monitoring the children's Activity Rooms and Library, and helping with various set-up and clean-up duties.

Requirements for becoming a Support Group Program Helper:

- Must be at least 18 years of age (Some exceptions are considered)
- Must complete a three-hour training session
- Must commit to working one evening (two hours) per week for a minimum of six months

OTHER VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES (may vary for each branch location)

OFFICE ASSISTANCE (receptionist, data entry, etc.) Hours and duties vary for each branch location.

OUTREACH AMBASSADOR (training provided)

Ele's Place outreach ambassadors are volunteers that represent Ele's Place in a variety of ways:

- Inviting guests to Tours of the Heart at the Ele's Place nearest them
- Staffing Ele's Place information booths at volunteer recruitment fairs and similar events
- Representing Ele's Place at occasional community events
- Making contacts in the community to share information about our programs and providing brochures and making presentations as needed

FUNDRAISING EVENTS

These volunteers help with a variety of duties at special events hosted by Ele's Place or other community organizations. Examples might include: working the registration area, set-up and clean-up duties, decorating, serving refreshments, etc.)
